Plagiarism: the act of taking someone's else work and passing it as your own.



Six Ways to Avoid Plagiarism:

Paraphrase: put information in own words

Cite Sources: name the source (MLA)

Quotes: quote individual sentences

Citing Quotes: additional page numbers

Citing Own Sources: aid in self-plagiarism

Referencing: add a page of sources at end

GIVE CREDIT WHEN:

- Directly quoting another person's words
- Using another person's ideas, opinions, or theories
- Borrowing facts, statistics, or illustrative material
